Events 1 and 2:

50 Singles / 50 Handicap Targets-\$37.00

Each month you will shoot 50 Singles and 50 Handicap targets. Handicap targets will be shot from your longest established yardage.

If you do not have an established yardage, handicaps will be set at 18-yard line for Ladies and Juniors. Men will shoot at the 22-yard line.

Each month as part of the entry fee, every shooter is placed into a two-tier Lewis class payout.



After the Singles and Handicap have been completed, if time allows, we will have a Draw Backer and Fun Shoots.

The Tite Wad season will consist of six regular Shoots. To qualify to shoot in the April season finale, you will have had to participate in at least four previous events.

The finale consists of pairing individuals based on their top four scores. With the highest scoring shooter being paired with the lowest scoring shooter. Then pairing toward the middle.

These teams will shoot 50 Singles, 50 Handicap targets, followed by a 50-bird Backer. The Backer will be shot from the 27-yard line (regardless of shooters' handicap).

The teams total score will determine the season's winners. The top three teams will be paid.

\$100 of added money will be contributed by HTSC.

During the April Finale only, there will be a Calcutta between the Singles and Handicap portions of the event. Any team not purchased outright will go into a "pot" and it will be sold to the highest bidder. 100% of winnings go to the Buyers.
